### **Campus Compact is now accepting applications for the 2010 Thomas Ehrlich Civically Engaged Faculty Award.**

The Ehrlich Award recognizes faculty for exemplary leadership in advancing students' civic learning and higher education's contributions to the public good, including teaching with engaged pedagogies, fostering reciprocal community partnerships, building institutional support for service-learning and civic engagement, conducting community-based research, and other means of acting on individual and institutional civic commitments. One award of \$2,000 will be granted to a faculty member from a Campus Compact member institution. Up to ten finalists will also be selected and recognized.

The recipient will be announced on June 11, 2010 on the Campus Compact website and honored at the national AAC&U conference that will be held January 26–29, 2011 in San Francisco, California. The recipient will receive the award, free conference registration to attend AAC&U, lodging, and airfare to the conference. Nominations will be accepted via colleagues, community partners, college presidents, provosts, or self-nominations.

- STEP TWO: Fill out the nomination cover sheet.
- STEP THREE: Provide supportive documents.
  - A letter of nomination from a colleague or self (limit 3 pages)
  - A curriculum vita (limit 8 pages)
  - A letter of support from a community partner (limit 3 pages)
  - Essay from the nominee that addresses the three selection criteria
  - A service-learning course syllabus
    - Evidence of deeply engaged, high-quality academic work
    - Evidence of community collaboration and change
    - Evidence of institutional impact:(limit 5 pages)
